



**Peninsula Piecemakers Quilt Guild
(PPQG) 2024 Quilt Show Rules**
“Peace by Piece”



Maximum quilt size is to be no larger than 120” x 120”

Entrants may enter a maximum of three (3) quilts that they made. To be judged by Viewer’s Choice.

Quilts must be completed in the last five (5) years.

Quilting method (hand, long-armed, quilt as you go, domestic machine, tied, etc.) must be identified, as well as, the person who quilted it.

A brief artist statement is required for each quilt entered.

Quilts must be in excellent condition. Any quilt submitted that is incomplete, torn, soiled or has a strong odor (smoke, pet, moth balls, perfume, etc...) will not qualify for entry or be displayed. There will be no refund if the quilt is not displayed for any of these reasons.

PPQG is not responsible for damage or loss.

All quilt entries must have a 4-inch hanging sleeve, except for small wall quilts (smaller than 24”) and wearables. These may be displayed using pant or regular clothing hangers. Odd-shaped quilts and quilts with multiple panels must be mounted on black fabric containing a sleeve. Quilts with electrical components or special lighting cannot be utilized due to fire safety. Quilts must be able to stack with other quilts and be boxed or rolled without possible damage to the quilts.

All entries must have a sewn label on the back bottom corner with entrant’s name, phone number and quilt title.

All quilts must be quilted by hand, machine or both. Quilting is a running stitch that passes through the top, middle layer (batting), and the backing of the quilt. The quilt must consist of three (3) layers (top, batting and backing).
